Asset Keeper Pro - Unmerge Assets

Unmerge Assets

The Unmerge Assets option is located off the File menu, Import / Export Assets, Unmerge Assets to Another Client File. This option allows you to copy (unmerge) and remove assets from your file into another Asset Keeper Pro file.

Assets can be unmerged into a new file, an existing file, or they can simply be deleted from a file.

After taking the Unmerge Assets option you will receive the following screen. Click the "Select Assets" button to select the assets you wish to unmerge.

Unmerge Assets

After selecting assets and clicking the "Close" button you will return to the Unmerge Assets screen. You can now select whether you want to copy the selected assets to a new file, copy selected assets to an exisiting file, or delete the selected assets from the file they are currently in.

If you select to copy assets to a new file you will be prompted to create the new file.

If you select to copy assets to an existing file you will be prompted to select that file.

If you select to delete assets you will be prompted to verify that you do want to delete the assets.

Click the "Unmerge" button to complete the process and you will be returned to the home screen.
